

Paul Doyle:

I'm going to take and provide you with the time and the focus and the individual attention necessary to be successful in that case.

Trevor Sharon:

We will meet with you for a free consultation. We'll sit down, we'll hear their story, we'll meet with them, and then we'll guide them through the process, what the next steps are and what this process is going to look like.

I'll then quote them a fee and let them know what I believe the cost of the case will be. If we can come to an agreement, at that point in time a contract is signed, and then I'll start defending the case immediately to create the highest likelihood of success in front of a jury.
